National Peacekeepers Day

August 9th is National Peacekeepers' Day in Canada to mark the single greatest loss of Canadian lives in a peacekeeping operation. On this date in 1974, nine Canadian Peacekeepers aboard a UN-marked transport plane were killed when it was shot down by Syrian missiles.

Nine Canadian Armed Forces members (known as the "Buffalo Nine") died during a routine resupply mission from Ismailia, Egypt to Damascus, Syria.
